### Guidelines

**Thank you** for choosing to use an Access Key for VersaLearn.

For your Access Key to be successful we recommend you follow these guidelines:

- Access Keys preferably to be attained two weeks in advance of event/experience
- Access Keys to be read calmly and confidently in an environment free of distractions
- An adult/carer or professional to read the Access Key with the 'participant' as often as required, to ensure the participant understands the Access Key
- Help the 'participant' comprehend the key points of the Access Key, consistently monitoring their level of understanding
- ➤ If using the Access Key as a reflective tool for people with cognitive impairment, enjoy the pivotal link between experience and recall after the experience has taken place
- Once the experience has taken place, revisit the Access Key to celebrate success
