For your Social Story to be successful, we recommend you follow these guidelines.


- Read Social Story often and preferably 2 weeks in advance of visit.
- Social Story to be read and shared in an environment free of distractions.
- Be calm, comfortable and honest when reading a Social Story.
- Help the participant comprehend key points and consistently monitor for level of understanding.
- Once the visit has taken place, revisit the Social Story to celebrate success.

I am going to visit Dudley House.


Dudley House is a gallery space for art exhibitions, functions, and events.



Many of the exhibitions and events at Dudley House are free.


That means I will not need to bring a ticket.

l might see people wearing name tags. They are called staff.

Staff will be able to answer any questions I have about Dudley House.



There might be artwork to see at Dudley House.

I can look at each piece of art that interests me.

Each piece of art will have a sign next to it, describing it.

My support person or a staff member might help explain this to me.



It is important that I do not touch the artwork at Dudley House.

I need to move slowly throughout the galleries.

This is important, so that I do not bump into the artwork.





I might hear footsteps on the wooden floor.

I might see and hear lots of people.

I might hear an echo in the galleries.



Sometimes the sights and sounds at Dudley House might feel too much for me.

I can bring my ear defenders or ear plugs.

There is a courtyard at the back of the main gallery.

I might go to the courtyard to take a break and get some fresh air.



My support person will tell me when it is time to leave Dudley House.

Other people might be leaving at the same time.

I might wait a few minutes for other people to leave.



Dudley House is a great place to visit.
