Guidelines

Thank you for choosing to use a Social Story written for the Mayor's Easter Egg Hunt, 24th March, 2024, at Bella Vista Farm. This Social Story is written by <u>Access Ability Australia</u> and is suited for a person who may live with autism spectrum disorder, alanguage disorder, social communication difficulties and/or a cognitive delay/disability.

For your Social Story to be successful, we recommend you follow these guidelines.

- Read Social Story often and preferably 2 weeks in advance of visit.
- Social Story to be read and shared in an environment free of distractions.
- Be calm, comfortable and honest when reading a Social Story.
- Help the participant comprehend key points and consistently monitor for level of understanding.
- Once the visit has taken place, revisit the Social Story to celebrate success.

Event Accessibility

- There will be an Easter party sensory session. This will be held between 9:30am to 10:15am on Sunday 24 March 2024.
- This is for children who may become overwhelmed in environments with lots of people, sounds, sights and smells. This may include children with autism spectrum disorder, sensory processing disorder or intellectual disabilities.
- At the sensory session there will be a smaller crowd a quiet space within the "Fit for Kidz Foundation" tent.
- There will be bean bags, sensory toys and headphones inside the tent.
- Families attending the sensory session are welcome to stay until the conclusion at 2:00pm.





I am going to the Mayor's Easter Egg Hunt at Bella Vista Farm.

It is on Sunday, 24 March 2024.

This free event is for families with young children who live within the Hills Shire to come together to celebrate Easter.

I will need to register for the Egg Hunt.



I will need to wear comfortable shoes because there is grass and gravel pathways at the farm.

I might like to bring a water bottle, hat, sunscreen, water, a picnic, picnic blanket and my headphones.

It is important to bring my ticket for the Easter Egg Hunt.



When I arrive at Bella Vista Farm, I will see a white information tent at the entry gate.



I will see staff wearing blue t-shirts.

A staff member will scan my ticket.

A wristband will be given to me to wear for the Easter Egg Hunt to show that I am registered.





There will be toilets, including an accessible toilet.

My trusted person can show me where the toilets are.



There will be lots of fun activities at including:

- appearances from the Easter Bunny
- cookie decorating
- face painting
- colouring in activities
- outdoor games.



There will be a place where you can pat animals.

I might want to touch the animals gently.

It's important to be kind to the animals so they don't get hurt.

There will be 20 to 30 animals including:

- baby lambs
- baby kid goats
- ducklings
- rabbits
- chicks
- hens and roosters.





Bella Vista Farm is also having an Open Day and there will be different activities to enjoy including:

- tours of the farm homestead
- Devonshire Tea will be available
- a Trash and Treasure market.









There will be a library caddy.

Children can sit and read a book or listen to a story time.





St. John's Ambulance will have a tent at the event.

St. John Ambulance helps people if they get hurt or sick.





It might feel busy and noisy.

There will be lots of people and lots of different sounds including:

- people talking, laughing and having fun
- children playing
- birds.

Some of these sounds might happen at the same time.



I can wear my headphones or earbuds to help with the noise.

I can wear sunglasses.

I can go to the Homestead building in the centre of the farm for some quiet time.





I can relax in the Fit Kidz Foundation tent.

This is a quiet space with bean bags, headphones and fidget toys.

In this tent, there will be workers wearing green shirts.
