This communication board uses symbols to share wants, needs, and thoughts, assisting individuals with communication challenges.

An example; first, we are going to the kids area, next the library, then the bus stop.

Ways to use communication boards:

- Point to symbols to convey messages.
- 2. Speak while pointing to assist board users.
- Read words aloud while pointing, allowing partners to respond with "yes" or "no."
- Encourage others to support communication difficulties by using the board.


